Astoria, New York, July 23, 2015: Snowdonia, a Welsh-inspired gastropub in the heart of New York City's Astoria neighborhood, is sending a few good ambassadors to the other side of the pond for a jam-packed tour of Wales. Co-owners Tom Davies and Carrie Spiller will depart New York City on July 28th, 2015, and make their way over to the famed Welsh countryside to spend time with friends and family — and to visit as many historic establishments, eateries, breweries, and distilleries as will fit in their full schedule.

Davies (of Welsh heritage) and Spiller have had this trip in the works for a little over a year, but due to the runaway success of their business have needed to postpone the journey — until now. “It was finally the right time,” said Davies, “and we knew that if we didn’t jump at the chance we wouldn’t make it for another two or three years. Visiting the country that inspired our gastropub is a chance for us to discover new recipes, potential partnerships, and the kind of character that you only get by going there.”

Now in its second year of operation, Snowdonia is proud to be bringing Welsh-inspired cuisine to the ever-expanding NYC hotspot of Astoria. Boasting a list of more than 30 craft beers, it has become the gastropub of choice for both beer snobs and foodies alike. Snowdonia’s menu features urban variations on traditional Welsh dishes like Glamorgan sausages, Anglesey Eggs, and Welsh Rarebit, and marries classic country flavors like leeks and mashed potatoes with more urban-style cuisine and locally sourced food.
